

  - Change from family housing to housing for students or the elderly












## New legislation in 2018 - developing plan for Vollsmose


- 1.000 residencies will be demolished








- Current Population of Hammarkullen is 7 982 (2021)












#### Hammarkullen



- In comparison to Gothenburg in general, Hammarkullen has:
  - Lower annual income
  - higher proportion of unemployed
  - Higher dependency on social benefits
- The area is characterized by insecurity and there is a criminal network that to some extent has control over the residents.
- Culture of silence and parallel structures



#### **Unit for safety coordination**



- Very young children are at risk for being recruited by criminal groups
  - A new way of working for social services
- Hammarkullen has not changed despite different methods/ projects. The problems are extensive










## School as an arena - Lights On





#### Goal

Create more equal conditions for children and young people to grow up.

No particularly vulnerable areas in Gothenburg

#### **Purpose**

To create activities and contexts that contribute to more children completing their schooling and having meaningful leisure time in a safe environment.

The school's teaching and timetable are protected. The school opens up and public, idea-driven, and private actors are invited to contribute resources and activities

At the same time, the urban area is being developed, security is being promoted and confidence in the area is increasing.

## Differences in living conditions for children in Gothenburg



- There is a difference in the living conditions for children in high-resource and lowresource areas in Gothenburg
  - Which effects long-term health, education and income
- The northeast part of Gothenburg receives the largest proportion of reports about children in need of help from social services
  - Domestic violence is the most common cause in Northeast Gothenburg

# **Security strategy**



- The biggest challenges now: exclusion and post-covid effects
  - Statistics: home alerts, violence and using drugs has increased
  - More crimes takes place in homes because of the pandemic
    - It is assumed that only a small percentage of domestic violence is reported
  - School violence, youth crimes, disruptive behavior, vandalism and using drugs has increased
  - Feeling insecure, is most common near urban areas and railway stations
- Vantaa's security strategy follows national security planning instructions
  - The prevention of crimes and accidents make residents feel secure
- Vantaa's security strategy has four themes: domestic violence, drugs, youth and safety of movement.
- The security strategy is an important part of operational and economic planning




## Foreign language speakers in Vantaa's major areas and percentage of total population 1.1.2020

# Foreign language speakers in Vantaa by age group in 2020/2021



# The neighbourhood Hakunila

# **Tour of Hakunila in five minutes**

The neighborhood was erected in the 70's as a part of rural exodus to cities and Sweden.

Cheaply made element buildings were not meant to last for more than a few decades – hence they are now somewhat run down.

Central Hakunila is surrounded by a belt of middle-class housing and semi-rural landscape. Great outdoors facilities lie within walking distance.

Many apartments are big family apartments – meaning they now attract large migrant families – white flight is a fact.

Biggest language groups are Russian, Estonian, Arabic, Somali, Vietnam and Kurdish. More than 90 languages are spoken.

The area around the shopping center is a mosaic of cultures, not one ethnic group dominates.



## Hakunila in five minutes 2

Municipal services include the focus school, day-care centers, a library, a maternity clinic, a health center and a youth club

State-run services such as the employment office and social security office have left in the wake of digitalization and centralization.

Many NGOs work in the area.

Around the year 2000 the neighborhood had widely reported ethnic troubles and the image has been bad ever since. There are visible security concerns such as substance abuse, restlessness, vandalism, bullying – even in broad daylight.

The shopping center badly needs revamping.

Measures to make Hakunila more attractive to new residents and investors:

- demolish and rebuild
- high hopes for the planned but politically controversial tramway connecting Hakunila with other areas



Safety in Hakunila In the spring of 2021, a security survey was conducted of residents in the municipality Based on the answers, the Hakunila area has some challenges Concerns about radicalization, formation of gangs, and violence may provide an environment where radicalization become easier for individuals in a vulnerable state Difficulties in integration also accumulate in Hakunila The high proportion of under-school-age children in Hakunila means that through multi-professional cooperation and investing in early childhood education and the work in schools, many harmful developments can be prevented or interrupted through long-term work and smart allocation of resources.



## Some current strategies and initiatives in the area



- Police, the safety team, the youth services and schools in Hakunila and Koivukylä started closer cooperation begun this year, no extra financing.
- RAD2 –project aims to prevent violent extremism by identifying weak signals of radicalization began yesterday. Project includes a kick-off webinar to a wider audience and specific workshops for local stakeholders. It is financed by the Ministry of Justice.
- MEK Positive Discrimination Fund. Positive action is targeted regionally and/or to selected target groups. The regions and target groups were chosen based on residents in the weakest positions (socioeconomic status and welfare data). focus is on preventive work. The early childhood education department has recruited new counselors and psychologists to work in the Hakunila area.
- KOTA Educational Equality Fund. Preventive work in early childhood education has focused on pedagogical development processes and on recruiting new support staff including extra resource teachers and instructors for families and children.
- Youth Services. Support the growth, status and living conditions of young people and promote active participation and empowerment. Primary environments: youth centres, schools, streets and digital platforms.



# **CASE:** Hakunila

### **BURNING QUESTION**



Trust between migrant families and city entities with the aim of exclusion prevention: How do we ensure and provide equal opportunities for children and young people to engage, participate and be part of their own community through hobbies?

#### What we want to learn

How do we Grow safe, resilient, and socially sustainable neighborhoods where every person, regardless of their social and economic background, is given the opportunity to realise their full potential?

We believe that children and young people with hobbies create better social skills, are more connected to their communities and have better chances in life.

### **Key obstacles**

- Fear of government authorities
- Trust between migrant families and city provided services
- Cultural barriers
- Marketing and communication (language)

- Lack of knowledge of activities available for participation in area
- Difficulties in engaging children and young people in activities/ hobbies provided by city

# Focus School (pilot)

- Finnish speaking comprehensive school
- over 1000 pupils with 60 different languages
- grades 1–9, two school buildings (1–4, 5–9)
- Principal and two Deputy Rectors
- ❖ 44% of students have no guided hobbies and the same amount would like one.



# Current strategies for hobbies in the area focus school.

- **Finnish model for leisure activities.** The main objective is to increase the wellbeing of children and young people. The aim is to enable every child and young person to have a leisure activity they enjoy in connection with the school day free of charge.
- Equal Sports. In the project, we give a sport grant to the sport clubs that organize low-cost sport hobbies in areas that have less free time sport hobbies and have a lot of foreign language speakers.
- Yard Games -project (Pelipäivät) at local schools since 2019. Emphasis on creating a culture of getting together and playing outdoor games e.g. football, basketball and many other activities in the school yard after school. Aims to create an environment that invites kids/youth to play. In the future there's intention to build small organized tournaments inside the event.
- Schools on the Move Vantaa involves students in creating learning environment projects indoors and outdoors. Focus school yard was renovations. Schools on the Move coordinators take part in team building day with other associations, clubs etc to promote student's sense of togetherness. Students are also trained to lead activities during school days to other students.
- **Sport-mates / Hobby-mates** (Sporttikaverit / harrastekaverit) move elementary school students (7-16 years old) who have no hobby of their own. School curator or nurse directs students to sport- / hobby-mate and children/youth choose which sports or other hobbies they want to try. They usually have five meetings and families are involved in the process. Sport-mates work actively in Hakunila area. Hobby-mates also run small group hobbies with the aim of building up children's group and social skills.
- Sistema Finland Tempo Orchestra. Aims to strengthen relationships between children from diverse backgrounds through play. The orchestra offers children a free opportunity to play music regardless of background, evenly and without entrance exams. Families involved and often also learn instruments.
- Children's Cultural Centre Pyykkitupa, activities financed by the City and Ministry of Education and Culture. Focusing on children from 0-12 years-old and families.

One primary objective: To build trust.

Multiple strategies for achieving desired results:

Focus on early prevention through hobbies and creation of community.

# What is a Danish community development project?

- Based upon the Danish model of social housing
- Based in social housing areas and run by the social housing organization
- Supporting healthy communities by partnering with residents and the municipality to invest in people and programs
- Focus on social initiatives to add value to social housing communities
- Focus on preventative initiatives to assist marginalized residents



# The Danish model for community development projects

#### Financing:

- 75% from Landsbyggefonden (LBF) = National Building Fund
- 12.5% from the local municipality
- 12.5% from the housing organization and/or residents

#### Project lifecycle:

- 4-year project period
- Re-application for new projects under new terms and strategies




# How we work



An area based initiative (ABI) bonding, bridging and linking social capital

- **Bonding**: Supporting ties between people and groups that are alike (bonding)
- Bridging: Supporting ties between people and groups that are not alike (bridging)
- Linking: Supporting connection between the residents and people outside the community with power or resources





# Key challenge: Nordic Safe Cities

NEET residents is an acronym for "Not in Education, Employment, or Training".

This refers to a person aged 15-24 years of age, who is unemployed and not receiving an education or vocational training.

Lack of further education and employment opportunities for these residents has a great influence their future opportunities, as research shows how important these factors are in terms of personal future development.



# Examples of initiatives we currently organize

- 1:1 counselling and resident support/guidance
- Job and employment drop-in sessions at local municipal youth clubs
- Workshops and events about education and employment for youth
- Creating youth employment opportunities via the community development project (13–14-year-olds and 15+ year olds)
- Youth employment training, courses and entrepreneurship
- Outreach via municipal schools
- Outreach via existing networks and relations
